REALISM

Geoff Archer is a British painter and art historian born in Manchester in 1945 and now based in Cheshire. He studied architecture before changing direction to pursue Fine Art at Nottingham Art School, later completing postgraduate teacher training at the University of Reading.

Archer's paintings have evolved through several distinct bodies of work while remaining firmly rooted in realism. His recent work has expanded to include the disappearing landscapes of America, with subjects such as ghost towns, abandoned automobiles, vintage neon signs and the iconic Route 66.

Working primarily in oil on canvas, the artist combines meticulous observation with a highly accomplished realist technique. Archer's paintings balance technical precision with strong compositional design, revealing beauty and visual complexity in both natural and man-made subjects. Whether depicting weathered rock faces or the fading relics of the American landscape, his work invites viewers to appreciate the textures, colours and histories embedded within everyday and often overlooked places.

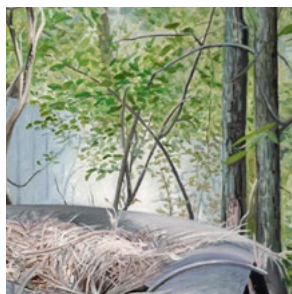

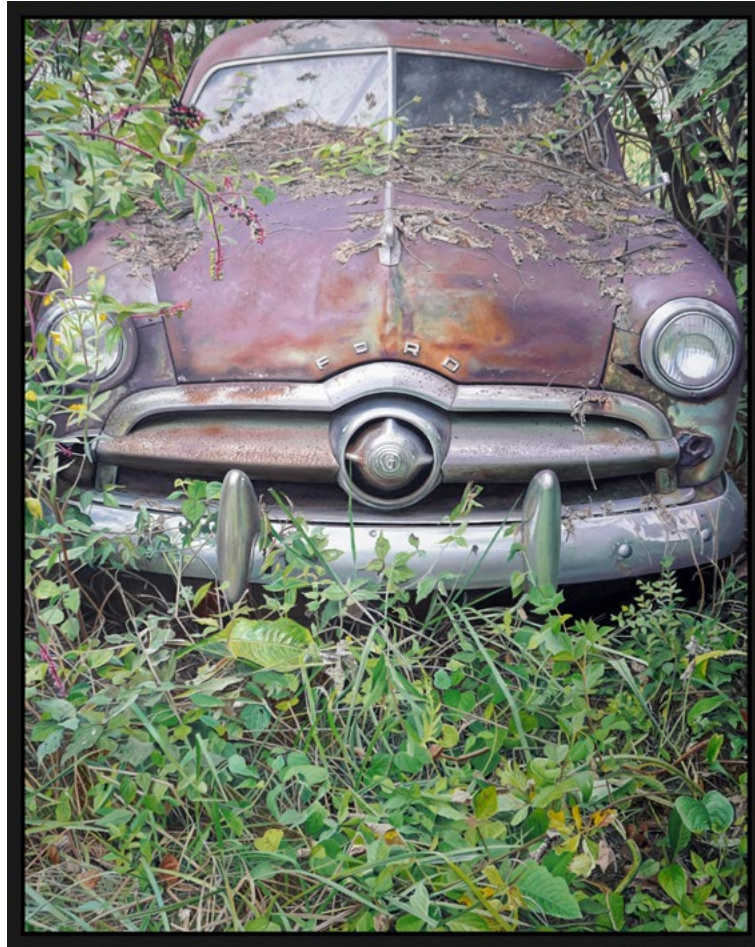

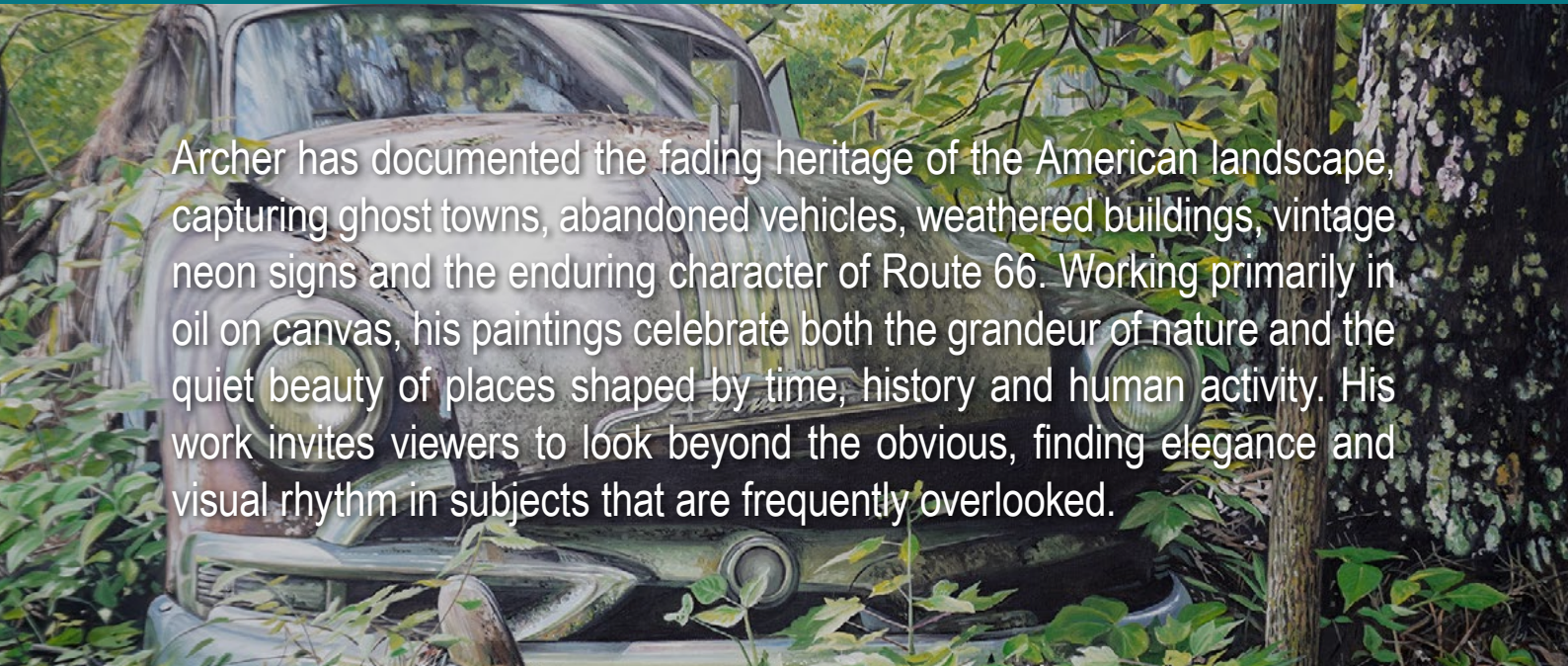
