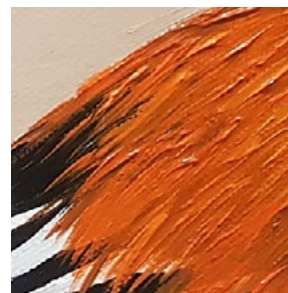
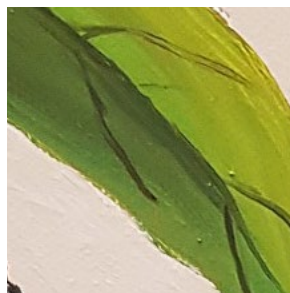
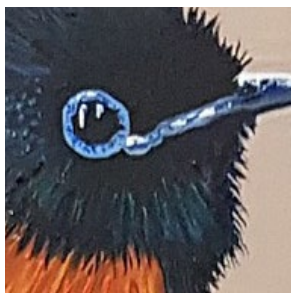

Best recognised for her expressive animal portraits, Lyons captures both the physical presence and character of her subjects, often incorporating intricate patterning and imaginative embellishments. Alongside this, her pop art works draw on iconic cultural imagery, reflecting an interest in graphic style and visual impact. Together, her work demonstrates a versatile and evolving approach, balancing technical precision with creativity and experimentation.

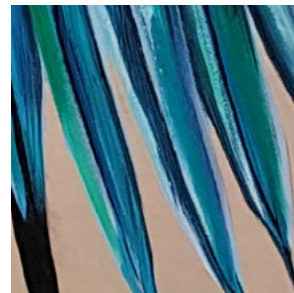
Kerry Ann Lyons has recently created a series of bird paintings in oil for the Oil Art Advisory gallery. This collection marks a departure from her more familiar mixed-media and acrylic approach, focusing instead on the depth, subtlety, and traditional handling of oil paint. These works highlight a quieter, more observational side of her practice, emphasising naturalistic detail and tonal nuance while still retaining her sensitivity to character and form.

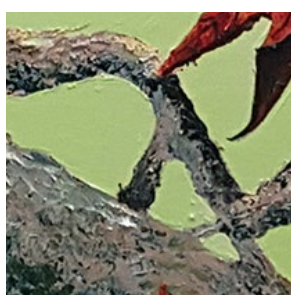

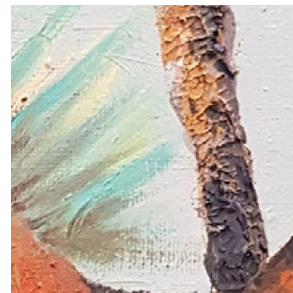

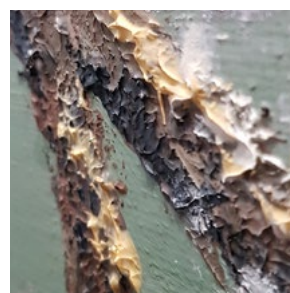

Her work is deeply influenced by a fascination with the natural world, particularly animals. In her wildlife paintings, Lyons seeks to convey not only anatomical likeness but also a sense of character and presence, often emphasising the expressive qualities of the eyes. These compositions frequently blend photorealistic detail with imaginative embellishments, such as intricate doodle motifs and symbolic imagery, layered into the surface of the animal forms. This interplay between realism and decorative abstraction has become a defining feature of her visual language.
